


**For those Healeys with the non-adjustable steering, this special socket will tighten the steering wheel nut without removing the trafficator's 6 foot tube. If you need to adjust the steering wheel position or adjust the position of the canceling arm, you need not withdraw the tube totally and all the wiring stays connected. A 4" lift will give the clearance for the socket.**

**Use a 1 1/2" socket, 3/4" drive. Cut (grind) a slot ~.400 wide to clear the trafficator tube (.375) then grind 2 parallel flats on the smaller drive end to take a 1 1/4" wrench or adjustable wrench.**
