

BJ8 Dashboard Alignment

The wood bottom edge and the centre switch panel form virtually a straight line across the bottom save the spacing for the rolled piping that goes between centre panel and top of console. See pics att'd.

That dash vinyl was applied by Heritage Upholstery and Trim and I don't know the exact brand they use. I use LePage's brand Premium contact cement for all my trimming applications. Sometimes on a porous surface a second coat needs to be applied before final bonding.

I finally got the dash out of my BJ8 and it turns out it is an aftermarket replacement also. It was mounted in an inventive way so I can't use the old panels as a template for mounting the new.

Does the assembly of the wood and metal center panel form a straight line across the bottom?
